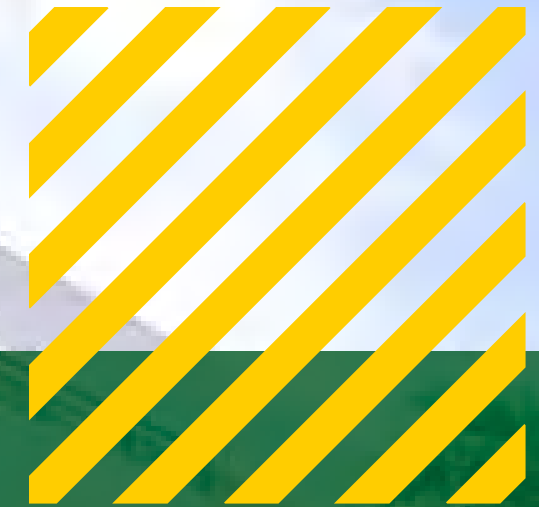




COLLEGE OF NATURAL & APPLIED SCIENCES

SCHOOL OF HEALTH



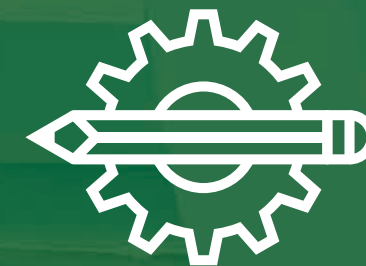
The School of Health is committed to improving the health, fitness, personal and social well-being of the people of Guam and the Western Pacific.

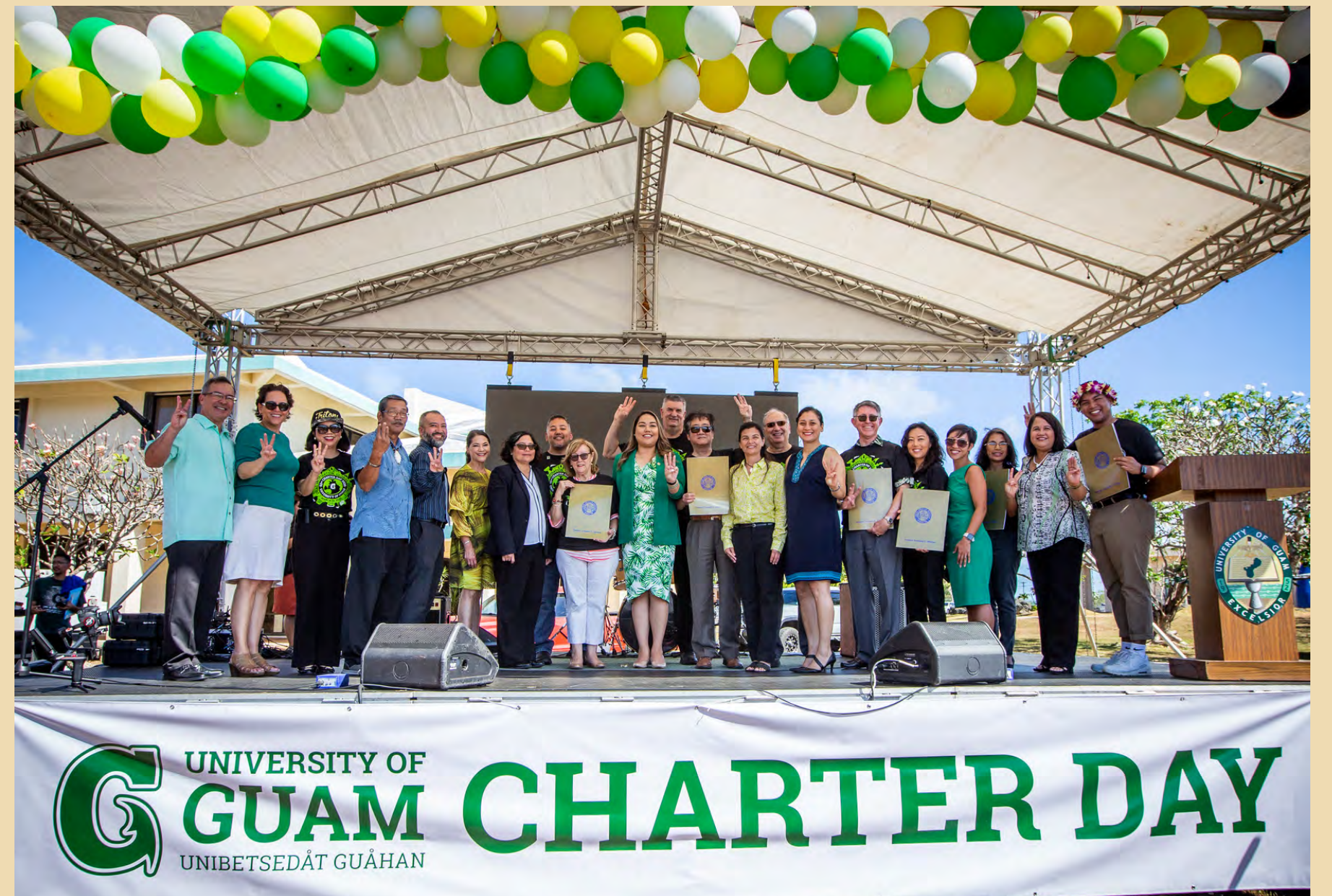
